Coronavirus Precautions

At The Gog Magog Golf Club the health and well-being of our staff, members and visitors is of highest importance to us, therefore we are putting all precautions in place to keep the Gogs safe and clear from infection.

Around the Club we have added additional hand soap in the changing rooms, increased our cleaning protocols and added bottles with sanitising solutions in high traffic areas. We have also taken the decision to switch off all PSI touch screen terminals to minimalise the risk.

The NHS advice is as follows:

**Do**

- ✓ wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds
- ✓ always wash your hands when you get home or into work
- ✓ use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- ✓ cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- ✓ put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash your hands afterwards
- ✓ try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell

Senior Management are continually reviewing the situation and have contingency plans in place for the Course and Clubhouse, in the event the situation in the UK worsens.
